Our History.....

1979 – Hanover Area Senior Center established

1986 – Renamed Golden Visions Senior Center, served 10 seniors and 3 adult day care clients

1991 – Relocated to present site at 1157 Eichelberger St.

2007 – On a daily basis, Golden Visions Community Senior Center serves 50 seniors, while Golden Visions Adult Day Care serves 18 seniors. Hot meals are delivered to over 30 home bound clients.

In addition to benefits for seniors, Golden Visions provides much-needed respite care for fulltime caregivers and working family members. The demand for senior services continues to increase. Considering the current attendance rate, it is projected that maximum capacity at the present location will be exceeded within two years.



Our Vision.....

Construction of a permanent 5000 sq. ft. home for Golden Visions Community Senior Center and Adult Day Care within Phase II of the Hillside Medical Center complex will provide these benefits for our community:

- opportunity to expand services and increase capacity
- direct access to established transportation via Rabbitransit, Adams County Transit Authority, and ACE Transportation
- convenience of Hillside Medical Center services under one roof: physicians offices, Hanover Hospital Medical Fitness Center and laboratory services
- build equity through ownership to increase financial security for the future
- provide community access to a large multi-purpose room for meetings, educational presentations, and workshops

As of May 2007, the Golden Visions “Hearts of Gold” Capital Campaign has raised \$187,000 toward a total 5-year goal of \$900,000.
